
M.A. Strategy and **International Security** (MSIS)

PURPOSE:

This master's program will equip students with an in-depth knowledge about strategy and international security. Students will study the 21st century most pressing national, European and international The MSIS is a two-years postgraduate program designed for students and professionals and will enable them to pursue carrers in international organziations, foreign services and non-governmental-organizations. The aim is to provide students with a better understanding of the world of today and the challenges ahead. The emphasis will be on issues of international order, international law, peace and war, emerging security challanges, as well as diplomacy and military strategy.

Due to the limited number of students, an excellent support and supervision by international scholars and professionals is ensured and our goal is to create an interdisciplinary and innovative research environment.

Bonn is an international city and an intellectual hub for young scholars from all over the world. The city offers various opportunities to gain practiacal experience in one of the United Nation institutions, countelss international organizations and international companies.




OUR PROGRAM:

In five mandatory modules you will gain fundamental knowledge about the content and methods of strategy and security research. This also includes international law, which is taught by our partners from the law department.

The Elective Module I was designed with other depeartments of our university in order to provide an interdisciplinary insight and the greatest possible freedom of choice. It also features an extended concept of security that also includes environmental security, food security and health security. The Elective Module II is carried out in cooperation with our Partner Universities and offers students the opportunity to complete a module in Potsdam or Tel Aviv. The entire program has a strong practical focus with an obligatory internship of three months. The program aims to provide internship opportunities through the cooperation with local and regional partners. The program concludes with the creation of a master thesis. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

An excellent Bachelor of Arts or equivalent degree acquired in Germany or abroad in Political Science.

Minimum Grade: 2.7 (Additionally examination requirements Numerus Clausus)

All courses are thaught in English. Therefore, an **C1-Level certificate** (or higher) according to the "Common European Framework of Reference for Language" (CERF) is requiered.
